DAY 1 (WED., SEPT. 12): DETROIT TO ICELAND.

DAY 4 (SEPT. 15): CRUISING IN COPENHAGEN.

This morning is free in Copenhagen, for shopping, museums, or exploring on your own. But do join us **this afternoon** when we will see and enjoy this colorful city in a very unique way – by **boat**. We’ll board one of the unique “**Netto**” boats that takes us on a **sightseeing cruise** through the **canals of Copenhagen**, like we did in Venice, Amsterdam, & St. Petersburg, Russia. Make yourself comfortable in one of the blue Netto-Boats and see Copenhagen from the water front. Enjoy the scenery that passes by while the guide tells about the sights, in English. **The cruise starts** from historic Holmens Church, & sails through the picturesque canal called “Børs-graven”. Then it’s to & through **Nyhavn**, the picturesque canal with many old houses and sailships. **Nyhavn** is one of the oldest parts of the Copenhagen harbor and dates back to 1673, and it’s where **each building is painted a different color**, like



Burano island in Venice. We’ll also cruise around “The Little Mermaid”, from **Hans Christian Andersen’s** famous book.

DAY 5 (SEPT. 16): A DAY CRUISE TO SWEDEN.

Another exciting adventure today, as we take a short cruise to **another Scandinavian** country, **Sweden**. We’ll spend the day in the interesting Swedish town of Malmö, with a very ornate “old town”, several **castles** & a popular all-pedestrian **shopping street**, the “**Sodergatan**”. You might want to try a Swedish lunch on the **Lilla Torg**, the most charming square in Sweden with many half-timber buildings from the **16th** century. It is so beautiful that it looks like a movie set. In addition to its fountains and cafes, it is adjacent to one of Sweden’s best and most popular markets. You’ll have time to **shop for Swedish** gifts & souvenirs. After a pleasant visit in **Sweden** today, we take the **short cruise** back to **Copenhagen** for one last afternoon and night in **Denmark**. Sweden is a different country, so bring your **Passport** today.

DAY 6 (SEPT. 17): FLYING BACK TO ICELAND - THIS EVENING WE SEE THE NORTHERN LIGHTS.

Our private bus and driver will pick us up this morning to take us to the airport for our short flight back to **Iceland** and the rest of our trip. This afternoon will be your best **shopping** day for **Iceland specialties**, and then get ready for a big day tomorrow when we leave the capital city of Reyjavik to see more of the **natural wonders** of Iceland. **But, for this evening**, we go to see one of the **7 Natural Wonders of the World**, the **Aurora Borealis**, or **Northern Lights**. The Northern Lights Mystery Tour takes you out of the **city** lights in hope of seeing the **Northern Lights**. **Aurora Borealis**, another name for the Northern Lights, are a **natural phenomenon**. We first drive to the countryside, into complete darkness, in hope of

seeing the skies glow. When Northern Lights have been spotted, you will be able to go outside and see the fantastic shapes and colors in the dark sky. You will have plenty of time to take photos and truly enjoy the moment. **Iceland** is one of the **3** best places in the world to see the Northern Lights, due to its location on the planet. It’s a **celestial kaleidoscope** with solar flares of green, violet, red or white lights, shimmering & dancing in a spectacular display in the sky.

DAY 7 (SEPT. 18): SPECTACULAR ICELAND TOUR.

This may be the most spectacular day of the entire tour when we go to see the “**real Iceland**”. (Did you read your “**Bliss Sheet**” last night, about today’s tour in Iceland?) It’s a **UNESCO world heritage site**, home to Iceland’s largest natural lake, and the place where the **tectonic plates** of North America and Eurasia split and drift apart. The plains of Þingvellir is where the Icelandic Parliament was established in **930 AD**, where laws were made, justice was upheld and sentences carried out. From Þingvellir the tour continues to the majestic and beautiful Gullfoss glacial waterfall and **geothermal** areas where you can get up close to the erupting **hot springs**. Returning to Reykjavik, the route takes you over the vast moss covered **lava fields** of Hellisheiði. Today will leave you with many Icelandic memories, & photos.

DAY 8: (SEPT. 19): HOT SPRINGS & BLUE LAGOON.

This will be another spectacular and truly Icelandic day for those who want to join us on the only optional tour of the trip when we go an area with an impressive collage of bubbling mud pools, **hissing steam vents**, and **colorful algae** deposits. It also features one of the world’s most reliable **fountain geysers**, **Strokkur hot spring**, that **every 4 to 8 minutes** blasts out a column of **super heated water up to 60 feet** into the air. Then, at the **surreal Blue Lagoon** you can relax in the milky blue **warm** waters and take in the spectacular surroundings. Relax in the warm waters of this natural **geothermal** pool, and enjoy upgrades like spa treatments, water massages and private baths. This is one of Iceland’s most important natural wonders, surrounded by snowy mountains and otherworldly lava fields.

DAY 9 (SEPT. 20): THE ONLY FREE DAY – FOR YOU!

Our last day is for **YOU in Iceland**.....for shopping, visiting a museum, taking photos of this spectacular land, or just exploring on your own. And to get ready for tomorrow’s flights! Organize your shopping receipts, & stay under the \$800 limit.

DAY 10 (SEPT. 21): BACK TO THE U.S.A. & MoTOWN.

We have to leave this amazing island country today, as we begin our homeward journey, with visions of Iceland and Scandinavia dancing in our minds. Meanwhile, **The Experience is Ended. Long Live the Experience.**
